**THE RULE BOOK
FOR EVALUATION OF THE CANDIDATE WORKING RESULTS FOR
ELECTION TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ACADEMY
(Consolidated text)**

Belgrade 2022

Article 1.

This Book of Rules establishes the criteria for evaluating the results of the work of candidates for election for a member of the Academy, in accordance with Article 27, paragraph 2 of the Statute of the Academy.

Article 2

A candidate who has obtained the teaching title of a full-time professor in the Republic of Serbia or an equivalent teaching profession abroad may be elected as a regular member of the Academy.

A candidate who has obtained the scientific title of scientific advisor or senior scientific associate in the Republic of Serbia or an equivalent scientific title abroad can be elected as a regular member of the Academy.

A candidate who has obtained the teaching title of an of professor or senior lecturer of vocational studies in the Republic of Serbia or an equivalent teaching position abroad may be selected as a regular member of the Academy for the Department of Basic, Specialist and Master Vocational Studies.

A candidate who meets other criteria established by the Department of Arts may be selected as a regular member of the Academy in the Artistic Area.

Article 3

A candidate who has obtained the teaching title of an assistant professor in the Republic of Serbia or an equivalent teaching position abroad may be selected as a correspondent member of the Academy.

A candidate who has obtained the scientific title of scientific associate in the Republic of Serbia or an equivalent scientific title abroad may be selected as a correspondent member of the Academy.

A correspondent member of the Academy may also be selected a candidate if he/she fulfills the conditions for selecting the teaching title of the assistant professor, i.e. in the scientific title of a scientific associate in accordance with the applicable regulations in the Republic of Serbia on the day of applying for membership in the Academy.

A candidate who has obtained the teaching title of an of lecturer of vocational studies in the Republic of Serbia or an equivalent teaching position abroad may be selected as a correspondent member of the Academy for the Department of Basic, Specialist and Master Vocational Studies.

A candidate who meets other criteria established by the Department of Arts can be selected as a correspondent member of the Academy in the Artistic area.

Article 4.

For the full member and corresponding member of the Academy, as well as candidates for academicians in the field of Art - music creation - may be elected a candidate who meets the following basic criteria:

For the selection of the full member and corresponding member of the Academy, as well as candidates for academicians in the field of Art - musical creativity, a candidate must meet at least one of the following additional criteria:

Article 5

A candidate for the Academician can be selected a candidate who has completed basic or master academic studies, that is, master's degree, or enrolled in master academic studies or doctoral studies.

Article 6

An applicant with at least one accepted patent or innovation in the country or abroad may be selected for the Academy's innovator.

Article 7

For an honorary member of the Academy, a candidate may be selected who:

- contributed to the appointed profession, art, sports and business, or
- gained the status of a meritorious artist or athlete, or
- obtained the vocational qualification of professors of vocational studies and the like.

Article 8

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its adoption.
